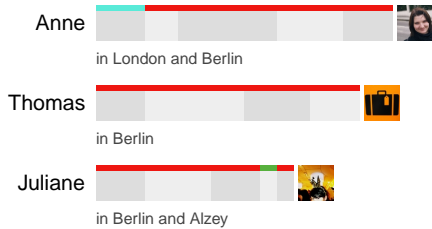


# First half of 2009 Personal report for Christian Lohse

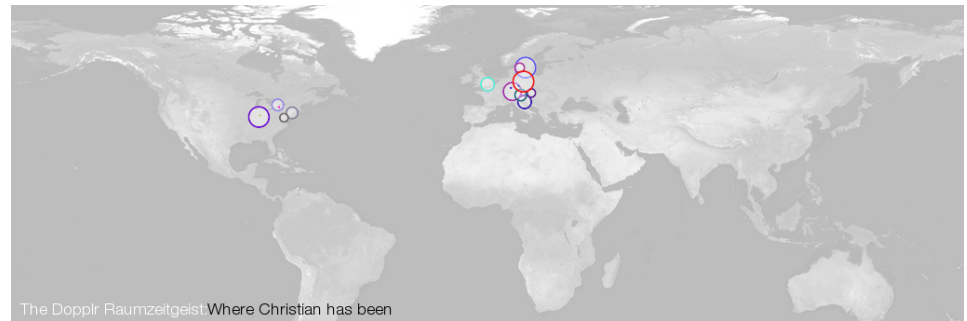


You have 3 travellers in your network. They travelled a total of 61,005 km. In 2008, everyone on Dopplr travelled a total of 1331.4 million km or 8.9 AU: the approximate distance to Saturn from the Earth as of January 2009.
